Position Overview

The Division of Endocrinology & Metabolism at UC San Diego is recruiting a board-certified/board-eligible **Clinical Endocrinologist** for a **hybrid inpatient–outpatient** position. This full-time role is ideal for an academically oriented clinician who enjoys managing complex endocrine disorders across care settings and contributing to the training of medical students, residents, and fellows in a vibrant academic environment.

Clinical Responsibilities

- Provide inpatient care on the **endocrinology and diabetes consult services** at UCSD’s major teaching hospitals, working alongside a collaborative multidisciplinary team of APPs, RNs, pharmacists, trainees, and faculty.
 - Maintain an **outpatient clinic** focused on general endocrinology and diabetes care, with potential to develop or contribute to a specialized area of interest (e.g., pituitary, adrenal, bone, or thyroid).
 - Participate in **shared call** with faculty colleagues.
 - Deliver high-quality, evidence-based, and timely care to a diverse population of patients referred for complex endocrine evaluation and management.

Academic and Teaching Expectations

- Teach and supervise medical students, internal medicine residents, and endocrinology fellows in both inpatient and outpatient settings.
 - Engage in scholarly activity (clinical research, quality improvement, medical education), commensurate with interest and appointment series.
 - Attend and contribute to divisional conferences, journal clubs, and continuing education efforts.

- MD, DO, or equivalent degree.
 - Board certified or board eligible in Endocrinology, Diabetes & Metabolism.
 - California medical license or eligibility at the time of hire.
 - Demonstrated commitment to providing compassionate, inclusive, patient-centered care.
 - Interest in academic medicine and participation in clinical education.

- Prior experience in both inpatient and outpatient endocrinology.
 - Interest in quality improvement, systems-based practice, or clinical innovation.
 - Experience working in interdisciplinary teams and academic health systems.
 - Interest in subspecialty focus (optional, but welcome).
